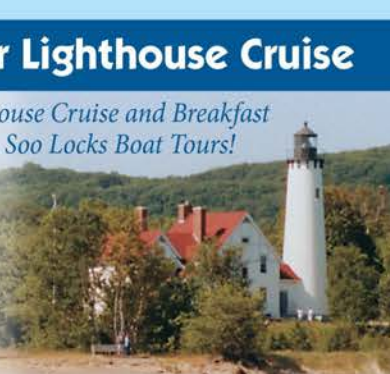




St. Mary's River Lighthouse Cruise

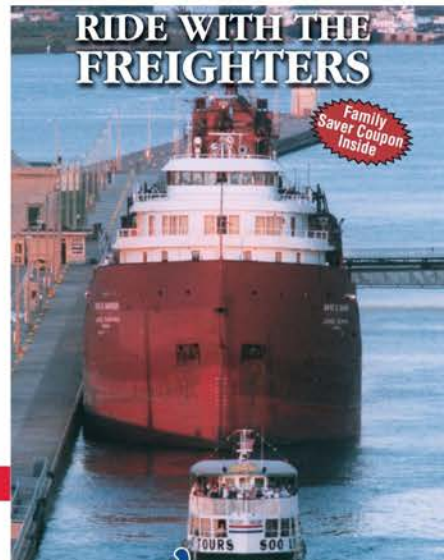

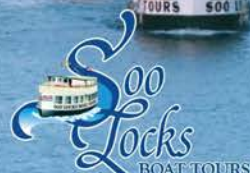
